unexpectedly 06621 ## petha` {peh'- thah}; from an unused root meaning to open (the eyes); a wink, i.e. moment [compare 06597] (used only [with or without preposition] adverbially, quickly or {unexpectedly}): — at an instant, suddenly, X very.

unexpectedly 0869 - aphno {af'-no}; adverb from 0852 (contraction); unawares, i.e. {unexpectedly}: -- suddenly.

unexpectedly 1810 - exaiphnes {ex-ah'-eef-nace}; from 1537 and the base of 0160; of a sudden ({unexpectedly}): --suddenly. Compare 1819.

unexpectedly 1819 - exapina {ex-ap'-ee-nah}; from 1537 and a derivative of the same as 0160; of a sudden, i.e. {unexpectedly}: -- suddenly. Compare 1810.
