Sidon ^ 40\_MAT\_11\_21 Woe <3759> unto thee <4671>, Chorazin <5523>! woe <3759> unto thee <4671>, Bethsaida <0966>! for <3754> if <1487> the mighty works <1411>, which <3588> were done <1096> (5637) in <1722> you <5213>, had been done <1096> (5633) in <1722> Tyre <5184> and <2532> {Sidon} <4605>, they would have repented <3340> (5656) long ago <0302> <3819> in <1722> sackcloth <4526> and <2532> ashes <4700>.
